9.0	COMMENTS AND GENERAL OBSERVATIONS	12
9.1	The Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences observed that there were no	13
	provisions of the purchase and installation of television sets in staff's	14
	offices in the attached bill of quantities for the Procurement and	15
	Installation of Furnishing for the Department of Economics.	16
9.2	It was explained that the University Governing Council's Policy on the	17
	provision of television sets for staff in the University restricts it to	18
	common rooms only.	19
9.3	The Dean of Postgraduate school observed that some offices at the	20
	Postgraduate School Annex had been allocated to users who are not staff	21
	of the Postgraduate School especially considering the fact that some staff	22
	of the Unit were not having offices.	23
9.4	It was explained that t was the Space Allocation Committee that did the	24
	allocations. The Vice-Chancellor, however, promised to liaise with to the	25

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.,,	Committee to see to it that, in such circumstances, offices are allocated to	1
	staff directly affected before considering others.	2
9.5	The Dean, Faculty of Environmental Sciences observed that the	3
	Department of Geography had some water equipment that had not been	4
	put to use since they were purchased many years ago but the planned	5
	hands-on training and maintenance of selected Laboratory equipment did	6
	not include them.	7
9.6	The meeting was informed that the training would come in phases with	8
	Faculty of Science coming first.	9
9.7	In a similar vein, it was observed that there was shortage of lecture halls at	10
	the College of Health Sciences and that the College had been excluded in	11
	the provision of Laboratory equipment. It was explained that the College	12
	of Health Sciences had the autonomy for the procurement and installation	13
	of Laboratory equipment and related matters.	14
9.8	The Board noted with concern that the recent Report on the Analysis of	15
	Pre-qualification/Tender for various procurements which had just been	16
	considered indicated that in most cases, mostly the companies that bided	17
	did not have the mandatory requirements. It was further observed that the	18
	fee of ten thousand naira only (N10,000.00) per Lot was too meager and	19
	may be responsible for the situation described above.	20
9.9	It was explained that the amount of ten thousand naira only N10,000.00)	21
	was a fixed amount by the Bureau of Public Procurement which also	22
	allows for one Contractor to win a maximum of three (30) contracts in the	23
	same organization at a time.	24
