BACKGROUND

The implementation of the CEFTER programmes at the Akperan Orshi College of Agriculture Yandev, began in June 2015 when the college proposal for short training and extension services in post-harvest management was approved by the resource persons during the curriculum international workshop organised by the Centre for Food Technology and Research, Benue state university Makurdi. A thirteen member technical committee to coordinate the implementation of CEFTER programmes in the college was constituted with the following membership:

The Akperan Orshi College of Agriculture Yandev is a partner to the BSU CEFTER with the mandate of conducting short training, research and extension services in post harvest management of agricultural produce with the specific objective of reducing post harvest losses in the region.

Three academic programmes were approved for implementation of CEFTER activities at the AOCAAY, they are:

- i. Crop Processing and Storage Engineering (National Diploma (ND) and Certificate courses).
- ii. Crop Pest and Disease Control (National Diploma (ND) and Certificate courses).
- iii. Produce Management and Extension (National Diploma (ND) and Certificate courses).

These programmes have been integrated in to the Agricultural Engineering Technology Department and Agricultural Technology based on relevance and the fact that these departments are fully accredited by the NBTE to train and award National Diploma. The main requirement for admission is as approved for these departments by the NBTE. Thirty academic staff (Lecturers and Instructors) were recruited to handle courses in the three programmes as can be seen in appendix ii. It was approved that lecturers and instructors should be paid N800 and 700 per work hour respectively, from the project IGR.

Following numerous activities of the project, a partnership budget of N78, 504,450 was submitted and approved for the period of five years and spread as follows:

Year 1 = ₦29, 973, 225
Year 2 = ₦ 14, 831, 175
Year 3 = ₦ 12, 353,700
Year 4 = ₦ 10, 621, 200
Year 5 = ₦ 10, 621, 200

It was expected that the IGR will continue to increase as the project lasts, so that there will be sustainability even after the withdrawal of sponsorship by the World Bank.

Three components were captured in the budget (source of income and their respective parentages of contribution for successful implementation of budget work plan):

- i. ACE (Grant) 70%
- ii. IGR 20%
- iii. AOCAY 10%

The CEFTER project commenced in the college in June 2015 and the sum of N738,000 was spent by the college in running CEFTER activities up till December 2015 when the first ACE money was accessed. When the sum of N3,895,760 was paid into the AOCAY CEFTER account by the BSU CEFTER, the sum of seven hundred and thirty eight thousand naira (N738,000) only was accordingly transferred or returned to the college immediately.

The implementation of the CEFTER programmes is based on three components of the budget. The grant, the internally generated revenue (IGR) of the project (from school fees,

other charges and workshops) and the contribution of the host institution (AOCAY). But so far is the IGR and AOCAY that have remained consistent.

The total money received from ACE (grant) since commencement of implementation is **eight million eight hundred and ninety five thousand and seven hundred and sixty naira(N8,895,760)** only. The Akperan Orshi College of Agriculture Yandev (AOCAY) has donated lecture halls, students hostels, offices, land for practical and research and office furnitures. The IGR of the project which has remained the life wire of the project as at Oct. 2017 stood at **fifteen million and seventy seven thousand two hundred and fifty naira ninty eight kobo (N15, 077, 250.98k)**. Breakdown of the project monthly income and expenditure on activities since commencement is presented in table 1.

PROJECT SUCCESSES

The AOCAY CEFTER commenced activities in 2015 and accessed the 1st grant disbursement in December 2015. Since then activities have been on. One hundred and seventeen (117) students were matriculated into the three CEFTER programmes in the 2015/2016 and are preparing for the final year examination.

During the 2016/2017 admission, 102 students were matriculated, making a total of 219 students. List of ND1 and ND11 students is shown at appendix iii

Different research groups in the area of post-harvest management and control have been formed and are working on different aspects. Some of the areas include food packaging, crop drying, food preparation, food preservation, crop and animal product storage, handling, marketing and food hygiene.

The college management also approved the award of scholarship to deserving AOCAY CEFTER students which is sponsored from IGR and the first set of beneficiaries is shown in tables 2 and 3.

AOCAY CEFTER has remained committed to ensuring that results are presented to the college academic board for timely approval. It has been the practice of the project and the college to ensure that pre-payment and post – payment auditing are thoroughly observed in line with project and college financial regulations.

CEFTER has renovated a lecture hall (Hal 11) as part of its contribution to infrastructural development of the college as contained in the approved budget (appendix iv). Lab equipment and materials are also being awaited from the BSU CEFTER. The AOCAY CEFTER is committed to ensuring continuous implementation of CEFTER Programme and

has continued to work even when college staff are on strike. The project has taken practical, excursion and students industrial work experience scheme (SIWES) seriously in order to introduce student to necessary exposure and knowledge to be able to address societal post harvest challenges.

The management of the AOCAY has donated all relevant infrastructures such as lecture halls, offices, furniture, student's hostel and land to CEFTER. It has also ensured that all CEFTER programmes are integrated into accredited department based on relevance for successful training and graduation of CEFTER students. CEFTER is equally required to assist with lab. equipment, materials and renovations to upgrade facilities in these departments.

The entire college community has welcome the project and all staff on project were selected based on competence and relevance, hence their commitment is commendable.

It will also interest you to know that AOCAY CEFTER has grown speedily and has internally generated the sum of N15,077,250.98k from school fees and other charges while the sum of N8,895,760 only has been received from ACE (grant). This gives hope for sustainability even after stop of grant. There is room for partnership interaction and we visited NSPRI to adopt emerging crop storage technologies.

CHALLENGES

The Akperan Orshi College of Agric Yandev has received CEFTER with seriousness and has exhibited her enthusiasm in many areas. The major challenge of the project is delay in fund disbursement. If not for the IGR, it would have been impossible to continue considering the fact that we are involved in training which is continuous and full of activities. The CEFTER project is about three years old and 70% of the three year budget which is to be sponsored by the grant is forty million and ten thousand six hundred and seventy naira(N40,010,670) Only, out of this only the sum of N8, 895, 760 has been released to us since inception. We are not able to do renovations as contained in the budget, fund for Lab equipment and practical materials is still being awaited, lack of regular fund for excursion, workshop, conferences, accreditation, admission, training, certification and maintenance is affecting performance and success rate.

Every fund request should be treated in line with budget plan and not until previous request is exhausted especially with the fact that some activities are continuous and implementation may be delayed.

CONCLUSION

I wish to appreciate the management and entire staff of the AOCAY for supporting the CEFTER project to achieve this growth. The college is an axis of the centre of excellence because of what the staff and management of the college are doing at various levels of participation. So much has been achieved in the area of admission, training, ICT and infrastructural development.

I wish to equally request for an improvement in the fund disbursement attitude of Benue state university makurdi (BSU), to avoid project collapse and to enable us meet up with our mandate, considering the fact that the project is activity based.

For our lead institution (BSU), we say thank you for taking us seriously on project and may the Almighty God continue to help leaders of the project to succeed in making the project sustainable, even after the stipulated five years period.
